IMPORTANT

Transit fares are not sold aboard vehicles. Exact change required for payment aboard bus.
Every time you ride with paratransit service, you must show your Paratransit identification card on OPUS to the driver prior to boarding.

(1) A client who does not have a photo ID OPUS card, when one is required, is subject to a fine plus administrative costs. At an authorized retailer, the reduced fare is available on a photo ID OPUS card only.

(2) The photo ID OPUS card is not compulsory for travel companions ages 6-11.

(3) FREE at all times for children aged 11 and under when accompanied by a person aged 14 and over who supervises them and holds a valid transit fare. Conditions apply for paratransit system.

(4) TRAM monthly pass corresponding to the destination zone also accepted.

(5) For this territory, Zone ABC monthly pass also accepted but it is not possible to combine with the STM monthly or weekly pass.

Furthermore, the application of fares and use of corresponding transit fare cards must be in accordance with the provisions of the by-law relating to the conditions of ownership and use of transit fares issued for transport services in the metropolitan area, A-33.3, r. 3, of the ARTM.
